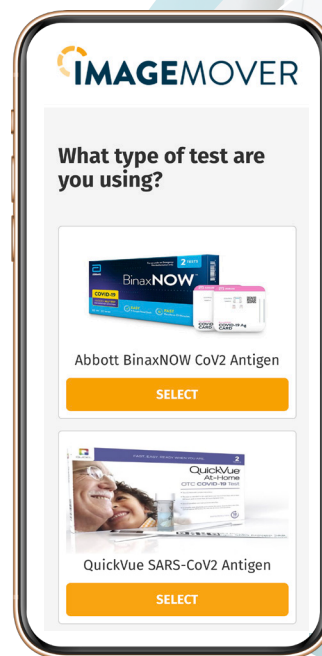




Enabling OTC tests to be FDA and OSHA compliant

FDA requires a “mobile application or website to facilitate results reporting” as a condition for OTC test developers to gain and keep EUA. OSHA Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) requires that employee self-administered tests are not also self-read. Point of Care Workflow Services by ImageMover enables any OTC tests to be both OSHA and FDA compliant. Verification Services offer automated, independent result verification which enables tests taken at-home to be ETS compliant, and results are automatically reported to health authorities.



Mobile platform fulfills FDA reporting requirements



- Mobile app and web interfaces supported
- API connection to state and federal CDC platform
- OTC and point-of-care test agnostic (dozens currently active)

Automated Verification Service makes OTC tests ETS compliant



- Test is rapidly, asynchronously verified
- Fulfills OSHA requirement that tests are “not both self-administered and self-read”
- Verified results provided to employer

OSHA compatible with visually-read EUA tests



- Employees can self-submit test result photos
- Much less expensive than proctored options
- Additional FDA clearances are not required
